

INSTRUCTIONS – CLUB PROXY FOR DISTRICT 61 COUNCIL MEETING

The District 61 Council is the administrative governing body of the District and conducts all business of the District. The President and Vice President Education of each Club in good standing are members of the Council and have one vote each at the District business meeting. If one officer is not present at the business meeting and has not designated, in writing, another active member in good standing of the club to act as his or her proxy, the other shall be deemed to hold that proxy. Thus, each Club will have two votes.

If the Club President or VP Education will NOT be present at the next District Council meeting, each may appoint, in writing, another active member in good standing of the club to act as his or her proxy. A written proxy, to be valid, must contain all the elements set forth in Toastmasters International policy, as identified below, and must be delivered personally, by mail, by fax, by E-mail, by electronic transmission, or by other reasonable means to the Club member who will hold the proxy. No other proxies will be valid.

The proxy holder must present the proxy in paper form (i.e. print out an e-mail) to the Credentials Desk. **If the proxy does not bear a handwritten signature, it must have the typed name of the club officer(s) giving the proxy or some other indication that the Club Officer(s) authorized the proxy to be given.**
